

THE JURY'S VERDICT.

**DEATH WAS CAUSED BY HEART
FAILURE.**

**W. B. Murphy, Son-in-Law of Iribarne,
Makes Important Witness at the
Inquest.**

The jury impanelled by Corone Thomas to hold an inquest on the remains of John Iribarne, who was found dead on Douty street Wednesday morning, after hearing the testimony of all the witnesses who had been subpoenaed, late last evening brought in a verdict as follows:

"From the evidence produced we believe the death was due to heart trouble, of long standing. There was nothing to show, or cause us to believe that deceased met his death from foul play, or at the hands of another."

During the afternoon the following witnesses were examined: Fred Hall, Dr. Charles, M. P. Morse, Mike O'Leary, Cal. Boyd, Sam Hird, Jas. K. Morton, C. D. Marks, Mannel Rogers, Dr. Weiser W. B. Murphy and Dr. C. L. Scott.

Mr. Murphy heard of the death in Fresno and came down on the Limited to attend the inquest. He is a son-in-law of the deceased and made the most important witness that was examined. He told of Iribarne having had trouble with his heart on former occasions, and stated that the relatives of the deceased all expected that he would die of heart trouble. After hearing Mr. Murphy's testimony it was easy for the jury to render the above verdict.

Mr. Murphy stated that the deceased was born in France, and was about 55 years old. His wife has been dead for two years, but he leaves two daughters, Mrs. Murphy and another daughter at New Castle.

The remains are being prepared today by Thomas & Rice for shipment.
