

## MRS. RIGHETTI DIES AFTER BRIEF ILLNESS

Is Victim of Influenza Epidemic in  
This City.

Following a serious illness of six days' duration, Mrs. D. J. Righetti, a resident of this state for 24 years and of Ventura for the greater part of that time, passed away Wednesday morning. While, in a sense, a victim of the present epidemic, complications arose in her case that made her chances of recovery very doubtful. The news of her passing came as a shock to the many who have known her here for years, an excellent wife and mother.

Dominica Wordabura Righetti was born in Aldures, France 43 years ago. She came to California in 1894 and was married two years later on May 11, 1896.

She is survived by her husband and two children, Julien and Jeanette; by a sister, Mrs. Antchango, of Ventura, a brother, Fernando Wordabura, of Reno, Nevada, and a brother, Mariano Wordabura, who is now in Italy, and by her father, who has reached the advanced age of 80 years.

The funeral services will be held on Friday morning at Reardon's undertaking parlor and in accordance with the present health regulations will be private.
