

TOOK POISON RATHER THAN HAVE OPERATION

BAKERSFIELD, Sept. 20.—At the inquest held yesterday over the remains of Mrs. Catherine Sanzberro, who died of strychnine poisoning Sunday night near here, the jury found that she committed suicide. The husband, who was virtually the only witness who knew anything of the case, said she took the poison rather than undergo a surgical operation which was about to be performed.
