

SHEEP MAN DIES; ILL FOUR DAYS

Peter Borda, a well-known sheep man of Gardnerville, died today in a local hospital following an illness of four days. He was taken ill Friday soon after his arrival in Reno with his brother-in-law, A. Uhalde, and was taken to a hospital. His trouble was diagnosed as bowel trouble probably caused by an injury which he received in an automobile accident near Lakeview last year.

A large number of relatives survive. He leaves a widow and four children, Lucy, William, Mary and Annie, a mother, Mrs. Mariguita Borda, four brothers and three sisters. He was a member of Reno Lodge B. P. O. E. and of Carson Aerie F. O. E. He was thirty-two years old and a native of France. The funeral will take place in Reno probably next Thursday, although arrangements are not yet complete.
