

Ownership Obtained Of Historic Rancho

SAN DIEGO, Nov. 24.—Ownership
of all the historic 15,000-acre Rancho
Guejito, near Escondido, was acquired today by Charles Lee Powell
of Pasadena, who paid \$96,000 for an
undivided half-interest held by the
estate of Jean Cazaurang, who had
owned it all and who was slain in
Nevada in 1929.

Several years ago Powell acquired an undivided half interest from Cazaurang's widow and the deed recorded today was signed by Marie Lees Thomas of Los Angeles as special administrator of the estate, which has been in litigation almost continuously since Cazaurang's death. Mrs. Thomas, a niece of Cazaurang, has been adjudged chief beneficiary under a will written in French.
