

## Accident Injuries Bring Death To Chino Sheepman

**Truck Overtakes After  
Broadside Crash, Pinning  
Man Beneath Its Weight**

Injuries received in a truck collision on Sunday were responsible for the death Wednesday afternoon of Jean Pierre Mutuberrria, 31, sheep rancher, of 1212 East Riverside Drive, at San Antonio community hospital.

Mutuberrria received a concussion and skull fracture when his light pickup truck northbound on Cypress avenue, collided broadside with a truck driven west on Schaefer avenue by Wilbert B. Jones, 39, of Pomona.

The impact overturned Mutuberrria's machine and pinned his head beneath its weight. He was taken to the hospital but remained in a comatose condition most of the time until his death.

He is survived by a brother, Michel, of Chino, a brother and four sisters in France. He was a native of that country and came to the United States 11 years ago.

An inquest will be held at 10 a. m. today at K. T. Heinauer mortuary in charge of E. P. Doyle. Rosary services will be held at the mortuary chapel Sunday evening and the funeral at Our Lady of Guadalupe church Monday morning. Rev. F. F. Watts will officiate. Interment will be in Holy Cross cemetery.
