Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Micheo of Gardnerville, Nev., have announced the engagement of their daughter, Mary, to George W. Abbott of Grand Island, son of Mrs. Walter Abbott of Reno, and the late Mr. Abbott.

Miss Micheo is a graduate of the University of Nevada, where she was active in campus activities, and a member of Kappa Alpha Theta sorority. Following her graduation, she served in Wash-

ington, D.C., on the staff of the Senate Judiciary Committee under the chairmanship of Senator Pat McCarran of Nevada, later with the Hon. Richard E. Poff, Virginia congressman. In 1952, she was chosen to serve as a princess in the National Cherry Blossom Festival.

Mr. Abbott, Grand Island attorney, is a grandson of the late George W. Abbott, pioneer Nebraska sandhill rancher. He is a graduate of Fremont High School, the University of Nebraska, and the University of Nebraska Law School. At the university, he was a member of the Innocents Society, Phi Delta Phi legal fraternity, and Alpha Tau Omega fraternity, serving as president of the latter.

For the past two years he has served as legal counsel for the House Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs. During World War II, he served four years in the infantry, including 14 months, with the rank of captain, in Europe.
