Rosary will be recited at 8 p.m. today in the Whitney and Murphy Funeral Home Chapel, 333 N. Second Ave., for Bertrand Maitia, 47. Requiem high mass will be sung at 9 a.m. tomorrow in St. Mary's Church, N. Third St. and E. Monroe. Burial will be in St. Francis Cemetery.
