

Eureka Pioneer Dies Suddenly At Los Angeles

Isadore Sara, sr., a pioneer stockman and rancher in Nerada, were held here recently.

Mr. Sara, an early day shee raiser, who was a pioneer i bringing young Basques to Ne vada from his native Spain therd sheep, had in recent year lived in Los Angeles during the colder months of the year, an died in a hospital there.

Despite failing health he had continued to make annual Sum mer visits to Eureka.

Mr. Sara was born at Misquritz, Spain, 86 years ago. He came to the United States wher he was 16, lived in New Orleans and California for awhile, and came to Nevada in 1886 with z friend. Augustine Garcia, and went into the sheep raising busi-

In 1894 he became a foreman for the Pat Martin sheep raising operation, and later for that of the Jensen Anderson Sheep Co. in Lander county. During this period he often camped in the Tonopah area, and reputedly camped on the very ledge where a fabulous strike was made by

In 1902 Mr. Sara established a meat market in Tonopah, but returned two years later to Austin and the sheep business. In 1909 he married Miss Mary Addans in Reno. Mrs. Sara died in
