GARDNERVILLE — Alice Micheo Nalder, 36, died Wednesday morning at Mono County Hospital in Bridgeport, Calif. A native of Horse Lake, Calif., Mrs. Nalder was born April 27, 1928, later lived with her family in Reno, and in 1937 moved to Gardnerville, where her father operates the Pyranees Hotel.
