

## Joseph Micheo

Joseph Micheo, 77, operator of the Pyrenees Hotel in Gardnerville, died Friday in a Reno hospital.

He had been hospitalized here for a week for treatment of a heart disorder.

A native of Spain, he came to the United States in 1908 and settled near Reno where he operated a ranch until 1937.

He then moved to Gardnerville where he operated the French Hotel until changing to the Pyrenees Hotel.

He was a member of the Gardnerville Kiwanis Club, chamber of commerce, Reno Elks Lodge No. 597, and the Gardnerville Volunteer Fire Department.
